Terms and conditions

Course Professionalism:

St John Ambulance Instructors are trained through an Instructor Development Program to become experts in teaching the public to become proficient first aiders at work, home or play. All Instructors are provided updated course materials/subject matter and are required to teach the requisite number of courses each year necessary for maintenance of good standing. To ensure appropriate Instructor standards, St. John Ambulance conducts annual course monitoring, refresher training and workshops, student evaluations for each class, and regular instructor communications.

All St. John Ambulance courses meet the regulations of the Nova Scotia Workers Compensation Board, Occupational Health and Safety Act and comply with the CSA Z1210-24 standard. St. John Ambulance is authorized by the WCB OH&S Act to issue first aid certificates and deliver courses in first aid. We are ISO 9001:2015 approved and offer quality products and services to our customers and clients throughout Atlantic Canada. All first aid kits are designed to comply with the CSA Z1220-24 Standard.

Course Attendance:

Minimum of 10 people and a Max of 18 persons for each private course (Emergency and Standard First Aid). Private classes required for less than the minimum attendees can still proceed, pending the confirmation and acceptance that SJA will be billing based on the minimum requirement of 10 students, unless otherwise noted.

Course Certificates:

Printed and digital course certificates are available for all students. In cases where the student names are provided prior to the class and adequate notice has been given and time permits, course completion certificates will be preprinted and sent with the instructor for distribution at the end of the class, pending completion. If SJA is unable to preprint the certificates due to time constraints, they will be sent out after the course.

Instructors Outside of urban centres:

There are no travel expenses (other than parking) for instructors, provided that SJA has an instructor available in that local area. In the case where we do not have an instructor available at the time of the course, reasonable and economical travel and expenses (mileage, hotels, parking, meals) will be provided in the estimate and are the responsibility of the customer.

Cancellation Policy:

Course fees are non-refundable. Private classes which are cancelled more than 3 (three) business days prior to the scheduled start date, will be subject to a \$50 (+ Tax) administration fee. A private class that is cancelled within 3 (three) business days prior to the scheduled start date, will be subject to a \$150 group cancellation fee. Failure to attend a scheduled class will forfeit the full class fee based on the minimum number of students required.

Payment Terms:

All course bookings to be paid in full, or Net 30 days for invoices with an existing credit account. Credit applications with references must be submitted in advance. Interest charges on overdue invoices may apply.
